2017-2018 Board Goals

Goal 1 - Increase mathematics proficiency for all students in all grades as measured by state and local assessments.

Objective 1a – Increase math proficiency for students in grades PK-2 and 3-8 by a minimum of 3% as measured by the STAR and the Wisconsin Forward Exam, respectively.

Group PK and K in one group because they do not take STAR math.

1st and 2nd grade goal-3% of the regular education student population below proficiency levels will reach proficiency.

Objective 1b - Increase math proficiency in grades 9-11 by a minimum of 3% as measured by STAR, Aspire and ACT results.

Objective 1c – Increase math proficiency in the Special Education subgroup by a minimum of 3% as measured by the Wisconsin Forward Exam, STAR, Aspire, and ACT results.

Objective 1d – Prepare all students for Algebra by completion of 7th grade and begin offering Algebra to 8th graders.

Goal 2 - Increase reading proficiency for students in all grades as measured by state and local assessments.

Objective 2a – Increase reading proficiency for students in grades K-2 and 3-8 by a minimum of 3% as measured by STAR and the Wisconsin Forward Exam, respectively.

Group PK individually

Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade goal-3% of the regular education student population below proficiency levels will reach proficiency.

Objective 2b – Increase reading proficiency in grades 9-11 by a minimum of 3% as measured by STAR, Aspire, and ACT results.

Objective 2c – Increase reading proficiency in the Special Education subgroup by a minimum of 3% as measured by the Wisconsin Forward Exam, STAR, Aspire, and ACT results.

Goal 3 - Continue to improve open, honest communication between the Board, Administration, staff and community.

Objective 3a - Plan staff appreciation and recognition activities/events.

Objective 3b - Increase attendance of community, staff and school board members at the School's Open House.

Objective 3c - Provide staff members with essential resources and training opportunities.

Goal 4 – Providing Academic and Career Planning (ACP) services to pupils enrolled in grades 6 to 12 in the school district.

Objective 4a - During the 2017-2018 school year, students will have completed 10 Activities related to Career Exploration.

Objective 4b - During the 2017-2018 school year, 75% of the students will have completed an annual ACP meeting with their advisor and parent(s).

Goal 5 – The school district consistently and rigorously addresses bullying so that there is no disruption to the learning environment and learning process.
