

Board Goals for 2018-2019

1. Mellen School District will provide a challenging curriculum to students.

- Completion of curriculum mapping by 2020 including related syllabi;
- Upon completion of curriculum mapping, appropriate purchasing of necessary textbooks and related teaching materials, purchasing to be completed by 2019-2020 school year;
- Purchase and full implementation of WISEdash local for education tracking of student academic performance and student behavior, and using resulting data to forecast academic and behavioral areas needing support;
- All students, whether starting at high or low level achievement will achieve a minimum of one year's academic growth each year;
- Alignment of Math, Science and Reading curriculum between and amongst all grades K-12 by the 2019-2020 school year;
- Complete implementation of a Gifted and Talented Program including an Individualized Learning Plan for each student whereby evaluation will be based on progress according to the plan with RtI time devotion included in the Program design;
- Hiring of a second Science teacher by the end of year 2021;
- Hiring of a Special Education Director by the end of 2019-2020 school year;
- Provide qualified and well trained Special Education staff. Improve inclusion of Special Education students into the classroom by 2020 to the maximum extent possible. Quarterly reports measuring academic growth of Special Education students including recommendations for improving academic achievement including plan development to address areas of need for growth and development.

2. Facilities

- Improving learning spaces and updating of facilities in Science department;
- Generate a Playground Project Plan to improve and purchase playground equipment and facilities;
- Generate Parking Lot and Sidewalk Project Improvement Plan;
- Gym roof improvement

3. Safety

- Continue to maximize and expand existing security system to include improving Bell system, Fire alarm system update;
- Properly utilizing every security camera within the District to provide for proper security surveillance as their intended use at time of purchase;
- Building and Grounds Committee to meet with City about: safety improvements on Fayette Street with regard to trucking traffic; sidewalk clearance during Winter months; Police presence at crosswalk areas

4. Technology

- Technology updates related to Science department facility updates;
- Incorporating increasing, measureable technology into lesson plans in primary education, evidenced in curriculum maps and syllabi;
- Technology department updates including improvement of school website with updates on a daily basis
